OUR MISSION:

To detect, prevent and raise awareness on kidney ailments and to provide quality, affordable treatment to underprivileged people

TANKER (an acronym for Tamilnad Kidney Research) Foundation is a non-profit registered trust, founded on 30th June 1993 by Dr. Georgi Abraham Prof. of Medicine and Consultant Nephrologist and likeminded people to reach out to under-privileged patients with kidney disease.

TANKER aims to provide health care and financial assistance to those who have kidney problems and do not have the wherewithal to seek medical attention.

TANKER cares for the underprivileged, who suffer kidney problems of any kind, regardless of caste, creed, sex or religion.

TANKER along with our goodwill ambassador actor Suriya intends to set up subsidized dialysis units in other parts of Tamil Nadu.

TANKER with Actor Suriya's help aims to take kidney disease awareness programmes to schools and colleges all over Tamil Nadu.



TANKER UPDATE:

We have completed 22 years of service for the underprivileged with kidney ailments. With your help, we have meaningfully contributed to healthcare, research, training and advocacy connected to kidney disease. From June 1993 till March this year, TANKER has provided 180,188 free and subsidized dialysis for 891 patients. We have also given financial support of Rs. 116 Lakhs to 2471 patients as one-time contributions ranging from Rs. 5,000/- to Rs. 50,000/- for transplantation, medication, investigation and fistula surgery costs.

Our four subsidized dialysis units have a total of 42 Dialysis Stations situated in Ambattur Rotary Hospital (Chennai), TVS Hospital, Chokkikulam (Madurai), RVS College of Nursing, Kannampalayam, Coimbatore and in Corporation P.H.C, Nungambakkam, Chennai. We do 1,976 dialyses per month, of which 1,827 are free of cost with valuable help from the Chief Ministers Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) and other donors. At present, we help 225 patients in our units. We also have a dialysis facility at PIMS, Pondicherry. In November 2009, we started our HIV Dialysis Unit providing dialysis to underprivileged HIV patients. This is the first of its kind in India. We also support Kerala Kidney Research Foundation, which provides free and subsidized dialysis at Thiruvalla Medical Mission, SH Hospital, Kottayam and PVS Hospital, Kochi (Kerala). TANKER has set up a new unit in February 2016 in Imphal, Manipur along with Catholic Mission Centre Hospital with 4 machines and other equipment to the tune of Rs. 33 Lakhs.

Along with helping our patients, spreading the word about kidney disease is equally important to TANKER. We have reached out to more than 1.1 lakh people with the 712 Awareness Programmes we conducted at schools, colleges, law enforcement offices and public forums. We have also screened 16,000 individuals for early detection of kidney disease through our 167 screening camps. As the field of research in kidney diseases requires more attention and guidance in India, TANKER also gives awards for research in Nephrology and Service to the tune of Rs. 5 lakhs every year.



RESEARCH & SERVICE AWARDS GIVEN ANNUALLY

The Muthoot M. George Memorial TANKER & Kerala Kidney Research Foundation Young Investigator Award For outstanding research done in the field of Nephrology in India was awarded to Dr. Pinaki Mukhopadhyay for his research into "Malarial AKI a new look in pathogenesis on the basis of carbonyl stress". The award carried a cash prize, of 2 Lakhs, a citation and a gold medallion.



The Renny Abraham TANKER Foundation Love for Service Award for a medical doctor who has gone beyond the call of duty in serving the underprivileged was awarded to Dr. Nandakumar & Dr. Shylaja, a highly qualified medical couple who, despite having lucrative options, have chosen to devote their lives to serving an isolated and underserved population. The award carried a cash prize of 1 Lakh, a citation and a gold medallion.



The La Renon TANKER Foundation Lifetime Achievement Award given to two individuals who have done exemplary work in the field of Nephrology was awarded to Prof. N Gopalakrishnan and Prof. M. Thomas Mathew, two renowned nephrologists from Tamilnadu and Kerala respectively who are pioneers of renal care in India and also served the needy selflessly.

The award carried a cash prize of 1 Lakh, a citation and a gold medallion.



The K. Venkatanarayana TANKER Foundation Awareness Award to individuals for creating awareness of any disease, mental, physical and social. Dr. Mohan – Dr. Mohan's Diabetes Specialities Centre for his unstinting efforts to create awareness on Diabetes. The award carried a cash prize of Rs. 1 Lakh, a citation and a gold medallion.



The Ashok Sankaralingam TANKER Foundation Patient Endowment - for 3 underprivileged patients from our units in Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore.

Dialysis:



Ms. Anitha, aged 37, resides in Chennai. She is a divorcee and has a school going son. She is working in a private concern and earns Rs. 8,000/- per month.

In 2010, she was diagnosed with renal failure due to uncontrolled blood pressure. She had oedema and breathlessness as the symptoms of renal failure. She was advised for dialysis. Initially she could manage her dialysis cost from her own earnings. The cost per dialysis in private hospitals ranges from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 2,500/- plus consumables. Later on, she could not

afford her dialysis expenses. She joined our Ambattur Subsidized Dialysis unit on 11th November 2013.

She has registered for Cadaver Transplant in a Government Hospital. Her health has improved greatly after taking regular dialysis in TANKER. She is thankful to TANKER donors for supporting her with dialysis cost.

Medication:



Mr. T. Venkatesh Manjunath, single aged 29 years resides in Madurai. His father Mr. V.P. Thiyagarajan, aged 55 years works as a textile businessman. He is the only earning member in the family and supports his son for his dialysis. His mother Mrs. Amutha, aged 50 years is a homemaker. He had hypertension. Uncontrolled blood pressure was the main reason for his renal failure. He had swelling in his face and legs as the symptoms of renal failure. He was advised for dialysis. He did his Fistula Surgery in a private hospital and thereafter continued his dialysis. Initially his

father supported his dialysis expenses. The cost per dialysis in private hospitals ranges from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 2,500/- plus consumables. Later on, he could not afford his dialysis expenses. He was referred to TANKER Foundation.

He joined our Madurai Subsidized Dialysis Unit on 12th April 2007. He does not have a related donor. He cannot register for a Cadaver Transplant as there are no facilities to register for cadaver transplant in Government hospitals in Madurai. He cannot register in a private hospital as the transplant costs are between Rs. 5,00,000 to 7,00,000. His health has improved greatly after taking regular dialysis in TANKER. He is thankful to TANKER donors for helping him for his dialysis costs.



Mrs. Dhanam aged 55 years, resides in Salem. She is a home maker. Her husband is coolie and earns Rs. 200/- per day. They have a married son. In 2005 she had a problem of swollen legs. She consulted a doctor in a private hospital. After investigation the report showed she had renal failure and was advised for transplant. She underwent transplant on 02nd July 2008 at M/s. Ramakrishna hospital. Her brother was the donor. She is unable to purchase post-transplant medicine and has approached us for financial assistance. All transplant patients are required to

take anti-rejection medication for the rest of their lives. The monthly expenses for her medicine is nearly Rs.10,000/-. As she could not afford to meet her medical expense, she approached TANKER for medication. TANKER could provide the required medicines with the support of our donors.

Transplantation:



Ms. Rubasri, aged 18 years, resides in Kanchipuram. She is unable to continue her studies because of her illness. Her father is a cook. Her mother is a homemaker. She has a school going sister.

In 2014, she had symptoms of severe vomiting and odema in legs. After investigation the report showed she had renal failure and was advised for transplant. She was shifted to Government Stanley hospital, Chennai. She underwent transplant on 25th February 2016 in Stanley Hospital, Chennai. Her mother was the donor (Age 40). She has approached us for financial assistance for her transplantation. TANKER provided with the required items for surgery. She is thankful to TANKER for the support.

Investigation:



Mrs. Meena aged 19 years resides in Virudhunagar. She is a home maker. Her husband is working in a private concern and earns Rs. 8,000/- per month. In 2014 she was treated for the problem of vomiting. After investigation the report showed she had renal failure. She underwent transplant on 02nd June 2015 in Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai. Her mother was the donor. She approached us for financial assistance for "Tacrolimus Level" test. TANKER supported her to carry out the lab investigation with the support of TANKER donors.

Fistula:



Mr. Arul aged 20 years resides in Kanchipuram. He is unemployed now because of his illness. His father runs a soupshop and earns Rs. 5,000/- per month. His mother is a homemaker. He lost his brother who also had kidney failure.

In 2015 he had symptoms of swollen of legs and giddiness. He consulted a doctor in a private hospital and after investigations the report showed that he had chronic renal failure. Initially he managed the dialysis costs with his father's earnings. The cost per dialysis in private hospitals ranges from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 2,500/- plus consumables. Later on, he could not afford the dialysis expenses. He was referred to TANKER Foundation by his doctor. He joined our Ambattur Subsidized Dialysis unit on 10th November 2011. Jan 2016, his fistula failed. A fistula needs

to be done for a patient to have dialysis. This is where a vein and an artery are joined at the wrist to give proper access for dialysis.

The patient underwent surgical procedure for AV Fistula. TANKER Foundation helped him for the surgery costs. He is extremely thankful to TANKER for helping him for his surgery costs.

EPO:



Mrs. Jaya aged 51 years, resides in Chennai. She is a home maker. Her husband is a aged person. She has two daughters a son. She gets support from her children. In 2014 she had a problem of vomiting. After investigation the report showed she had renal failure and she was advised to take dialysis. The doctor advised her to take EPO injection [4000 Unit] weekly twice. She is now taking dialysis in M/s. Vee Care Hospital, Chennai with her CM card. She has approached us for financial assistance for EPO Injection. The doctor advised her to take EPO injection [4000 k] twice a week. She has approached us for financial assistance for EPO Injection which was done with help from TANKER donors.

TAPP CLINIC



TANKER Foundation in coordination with Rotary Club of Ambattur is conducting an exclusive clinic on every Saturday from 2 PM to 3 PM at Ambattur Rotary Hospital. A free consultation with a Nephrologist with adequate investigation is done at this special clinic. Some of the patients attending our screening camps and are of high risk, are referred to this clinic for further investigations and advise. The purpose of this clinic is not to miss out on findings of high BP and Blood Sugar since they are more prone for Chronic Kidney Disease.

TANKER INAUGURATIONS



Dr. Georgi Abraham MD, FRCP Nephrologist, Founder Trustee TANKER Foundation was on a visit to Manipur for a scientific lecture on CKD patients and the impact of Haemodialysis and their livelihood. Out of 8 North Eastern States only seven nephrologists are available and five of them are located in Gauwhati. It was found that the care given for CKD patients was in the lowest possible scale. Many of them suffered either due to inadequate facilities or due to the unaffordability of treatment.

This prompted Dr. Georgi Abraham and TANKER Foundation to raise funds to set up a dialysis unit at Manipur. Dr. Shaarath Kumar Prof. Nephrology, Manipur agreed to support the underprivileged suffering from CKD and Rev. Fr. Lijo of CMC, Manipur came forward to house the dialysis unit in CMC, Imphal.

TANKER Foundation with the support of donors mobilized funds for 4 dialysis machines, RO Plant and other required equipment for the dialysis center to the tune of Rs.33 lakhs. Fr. Lijo deputed a team of his committed staff to get trained in dialysis in Chennai. Training was given by Dr. Georgi and his team at MMM Hospital and by Ms. Padma .G of TANKER Foundation, at the Ambattur Rotary Hospital Unit.

This is another milestone for us in our work, by serving the underprivileged suffering from chronic kidney disease in North East India. The inauguration was held on 27th February 2016 at 3 pm in CMC, Imphal, Manipur.
