## Trustee's Message

Dear TANKER- Friend,

I have pleasure in presenting the Annual Report for the year 2019-2020. This Annual Report aims at showing our activities since TANKER'S inception in 1993 and the progress we have made this year.

We have completed **26 years** of service for the underprivileged with kidney ailments. With your help, we have meaningfully contributed to healthcare, research, training and advocacy connected to kidney disease. From June 1993 till **March 2020**, TANKER has provided **228,627 free and subsidized dialysis** for **1600 patients**. We have also given financial support of **Rs. 342 Lakhs to 3327 patients** as one-time contributions ranging from Rs. 5,000/- to Rs. 50,000/- for transplantation, medication, investigation and fistula surgery costs.

Our **eight subsidized dialysis units** have a total of **126 Dialysis Stations** and are situated in 1. Ambattur Rotary Hospital, **Chennai**, 2. Arogya Trust, Chokkikulam, **Madurai**, 3. RVS College of Nursing, Kannampalayam, **Coimbatore**, 4. Corporation P.H.C, Nungambakkam, Chennai along with Rotary Club of Madras East, 5. **Thiruverkadu, Chennai** with Rotary Club of Madras West, 6. **Vellore** with Rotary Club of Vellore Fort 7. Corporation U. P. H. C, **Retteri, Chennai** along with Rotary Club of Chennai Towers, and 8. **Perungudi, Chennai** with Corporation U.C.H.C.

We do **4854** dialyses per month, of which **4626 are free of cost** with valuable help from the Chief Ministers **Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS), Greater Chennai Corporation and other valuable donors**. At present, we help **572 patients** in our units. We also have a dialysis facility at **PIMS, Pondicherry**. In November 2009, we started our **HIV Dialysis Unit** providing dialysis to underprivileged **HIV patients**. This is the first of its kind in India. Subsequently we also opened an HIV facility with 3 machines in Parumala, Kerala. We also support **Kerala Kidney Research Foundation (KKRF)**, which provides free and subsidized dialysis at Thiruvalla Medical Mission, SH Hospital, **Kottayam** and PVS Hospital, Kochi. We have recently donated 4 machines worth Rs. 24 Lakhs to KKRF. In February 2016, TANKER helped Catholic Mission Centre Hospital, **Imphal, Manipur** with 4 machines and equipment worth Rs. 33 Lakhs. TANKER along with The Madras Medical Mission has donated a machine to the **Dar es salaam** General Hospital in Tanzania.

Almost 2.5 lakh people die of kidney failure in India every year. It is the third largest killer after malignancy and heart disease. Along with helping our patients, spreading the word about kidney disease is equally important to TANKER. We have reached out to more than **1.88 lakh** people with the **1271 Awareness Programmes** we conducted at schools, colleges, law enforcement offices and public forums. We have screened **35,343 individuals** for early detection of kidney disease through our **413 screening camps**. As the field of research in kidney diseases requires more attention and guidance in India, TANKER also gives awards for research in Nephrology and Service to the tune of Rs. 8 lakhs every year.

We have come this far with the support and blessings of god and all our donors and partners. We are very grateful to you for helping us reach out to more underprivileged people.

## Annual Awards Program 2020:

Our 27th Annual Charity Awards Nite was held on Saturday, 25th January 2020 at Hotel Savera, RK Salai, Chennai. For the past eleven years TANKER has used this special event as a platform to recognise and appreciate the efforts of professionals working tirelessly to improve the lives of people, especially the underprivileged. On January 25th 2020 the following Awards were presented.

**Mrs. Malathi Venkatesan TANKER Foundation Memorial Lecture by Mrs. Vasundhara Raghavan.** The Founder of the Kidney Warriors Foundation and a champion who works tirelessly to improve the lives of Kidney patients. Her Lecture was on “The Kidney Warriors- A New Outlook to the Kidney Disease Challenge”. Her experience in donating her kidney to her son and the lack of proper information about the disease, diet, transplants and much more made her start the Kidney Warriors Foundation which is

mainly a Facebook and WhatsApp group where thousands of people share their experiences and learn from each other. She also highlighted that there was a great lack of nephrologists in India and that the Government should work on this. She was awarded the “**La Renon TANKER Foundation for the Sake of Honour Award**”. The award carried a cash prize of Rs. 1 Lakh, a citation and a gold medallion

**The K. V. George Kottukulam Memorial TANKER & Kerala Kidney Research Foundation Young Investigator Award** for outstanding research done in the field of Nephrology in India was awarded to Dr. R. M. Anjana of Mohan Diabetes Research Foundation for her research in “Unsupervised machine learning model to identify the type 2 diabetes subgroups and their risk of kidney disease”. The award carried a prize of Rs. 2,00,000/- a citation and a gold medallion.



**The Renny Abraham TANKER Foundation Love for Service Award** for a medical doctor who has gone beyond the call of duty in serving the underprivileged was awarded to **Dr. Prahalathan KK**, Co-Founder, Bhumi for his selfless service in serving the needy and steering a huge volunteer force, especially during the Chennai floods in 2015. The award carried a prize of Rs. 1,00,000/-, a citation and a gold medallion.

**The La Renon TANKER Foundation Lifetime Achievement Awards** given to two individuals who have done exemplary work in the field of Nephrology were awarded to **Dr. M. A. Muthusethupathi**, the father of Nephrology in Tamilnadu and **Dr. Nandita Choudhury**, the first Nephrologist in the North East (Guwahati). The awards carried a prize of Rs. 1,00,000/-, a citation and a gold medallion each.

**CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE... A SILENT KILLER**

**1 in 10** CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE AFFECTS 10% OF THE POPULATION.

**WHO IS AFFECTED?**

- 10%** of the population worldwide is affected by CKD.
- Half of people aged **75** or more have some degree of CKD.
- 1 in 5 MEN** and **1 in 7 WOMEN** between the ages of 65 and 74 have CKD.
- Kidney disease can affect people of all ages and races.
- High blood pressure and diabetes are the most common CKD causes in adults.

- Do you have a family history of kidney disease?
- Are you overweight?

**HOW TO DETECT CKD?**

- Early CKD often has no sign or symptoms. A person can lose up to 90% of their kidney function before experiencing any signs.
- But it can be detected by simple tests:
  - a urine test to check if there is any protein in your urine, or
  - a blood test to measure the level of creatinine in your blood.
- Signs of advancing CKD include: swollen ankles, fatigue, difficulty concentrating, decreased appetite, and foamy urine.

- Make urine
- Remove wastes and extra fluid from your blood
- Control your body's chemical balance
- Help control your blood pressure
- Help keep your bones healthy
- Help you make red blood cells

**THE 8 GOLDEN RULES TO REDUCE THE RISK**

Kidney diseases are silent killers, which will largely affect your quality of life. There are however several easy ways to reduce the risk of developing kidney disease.

1. Keep fit, be active
2. Eat a healthy diet
3. Check and control your blood sugar
4. Check and control your blood pressure
5. Take appropriate fluid intake
6. Don't smoke
7. Don't take over-the-counter anti-inflammatory/pain-killer pills regularly
8. Get your kidney function checked if you have one or more of the "high risk" factors:
  - you have diabetes
  - you have hypertension
  - you are obese


