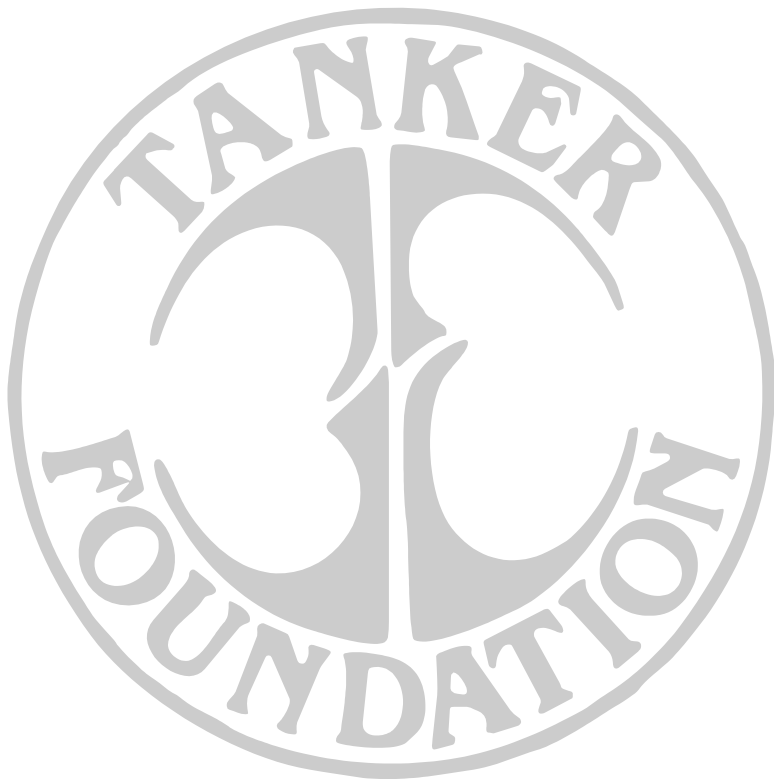

OUR MISSION

To detect, prevent and raise awareness on kidney ailments and to provide quality, affordable treatment to underprivileged people.

The TANKER foundation [an acronym for Tamilnad Kidney Research] is a registered, non-profit charitable trust, which aims to provide health care and financial assistance to those who have kidney problems and do not have the wherewithal to seek medical attention.

TANKER cares for those, the underprivileged, who suffer from kidney problems of any kind, reversible or terminal, regardless of caste, creed or religion.





OUR BEGINNING & OBJECTIVES

TANKER began with a small group of like minded people who were brought together by their personal experiences in managing kidney disease. It was founded on 30th June 1993 by Dr.Georgi Abraham.

TANKER foundation had small beginnings and initially only financial support was given for needy patients with kidney ailments. Later as contributions started coming in, TANKER started its subsidized dialysis facilities with the aim of providing subsidized dialysis and financial assistance for transplantation, investigation and medication costs for the underprivileged with kidney ailments.

LOOKING BACK. . .

TANKER in the process of helping the underprivileged with kidney ailments, started its first dialysis unit in Kilpauk in 1999. This unit has 11 machines now. The second dialysis unit at Ambattur Rotary Hospital started in February 2006 in collaboration with Ambattur Rotary club has 5 machines. The third dialysis unit at Madurai inaugurated in October 2006 has 5 machines.

Upto April 2008, TANKER has given over 45970 dialysis at subsidized rates and provided 9109 free dialysis. TANKER has disbursed Rs. 40,0000 to 599 patients as one-time contributions. These range from Rs.5000 to Rs.50,000 for dialysis, transplantation and medication costs. Totally we have 115 dialysis patients in the TANKER fold. In the year 2007-2008 TANKER has given 9722 dialysis of which 2703 were free.

The “Sponsor a Dialysis” [SD] scheme and project “Dialysis a Day” [DAD] are ways by which we are able to give a few free dialysis everyday. TANKER has also conducted many Awareness and Outreach programmes in schools and colleges, conferences and symposiums on kidney ailments and its treatment for the general public as a measure for prevention. For early detection of kidney diseases we also conduct public health camps and free screening camps in rural areas. TANKER also provides free fistula surgery to the needy and counseling to patients and care givers.

THIRD WORLD KIDNEY DAY

The 3rd 'World Kidney Day' was observed on 13th March 2008. TANKER conducted various activities and awareness outreach programmes on the day.

A Walkathon was conducted by TANKER in which more than 800 students from schools and colleges across the city participated. They walked a stretch of the Marina Beach to create awareness of the important facts of our "Amazing Kidneys". The TANKER team interacted with shoppers at Spencer Plaza and informed them of various aspects of kidney disease. A powerpoint presentation was made, pamphlets were distributed and a quiz was conducted. We also carried out a poster campaign in schools, the airport and book shops.
